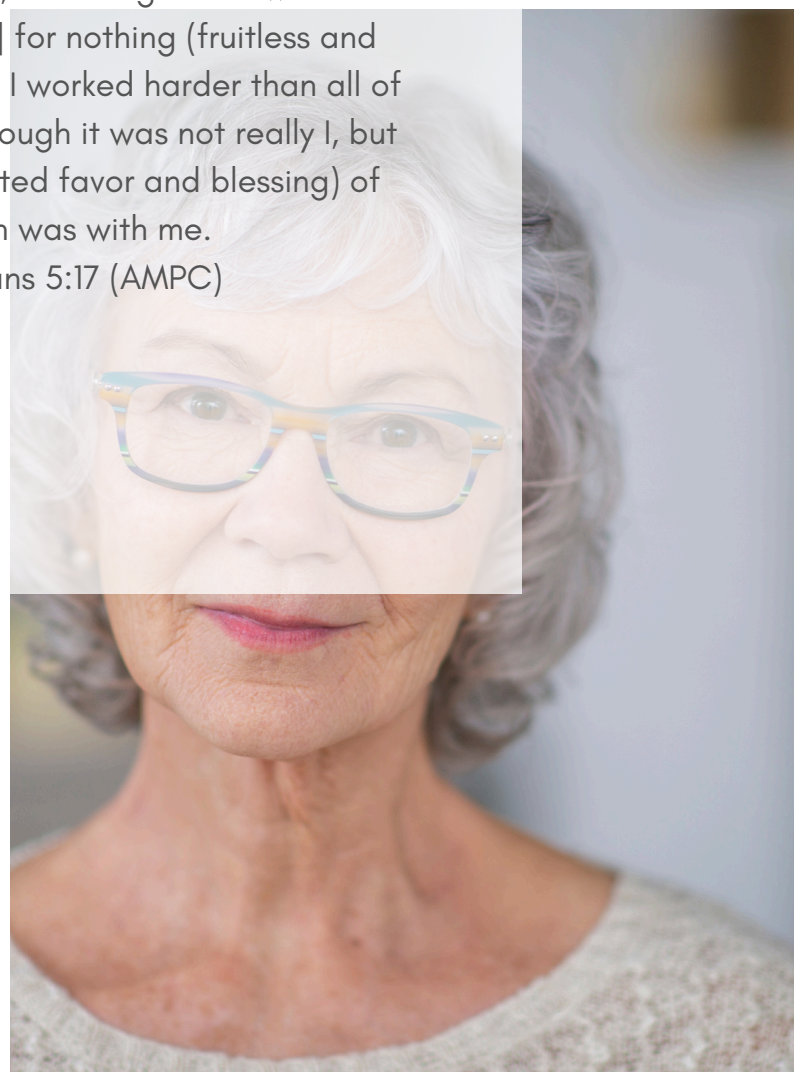




BY THE GRACE OF GOD

The #1 complaint I hear about affirmations is: “I don’t believe a word I’m saying! I know these aren’t true!!!”

• Affirmations have been around for a long time. You have probably used them without realizing it. Have you ever stopped in the middle of a difficult task to pump yourself up with, “You got this”? That’s an affirmation. It’s a statement which shifts your focus away from perceived inadequacies, towards your strength and value. There’s a lot of brain science going on to move you from repetition to belief.

Although I believe affirmations can help change your mindset, I also believe they must be cemented in truth: as in, the Word of God.

Our capacity for grabbing hold of identity in Christ rests in the authority and integrity of God’s word, not our own. Since His is the final and true word, we’re going to speak IT, rather than repeat random positive thoughts. His truth says:

You are not defined by the shame of things you’ve done or said. You are not crippled by opportunities lost. You are not bound by what others think of you.

God’s truth sets us free. His truth is the standard against which everything must be measured. And everything that doesn’t measure up is rejected.
