- Philippians 4:13 | I can do all things through him who strengthens me.
- Isaiah 41:10 | Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.
- James 1:2-4 | Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.
- James 1:12 | Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him.
- Romans 8:18 | For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us.
- Romans 8:28 | And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.
- 2 Corinthians 12:9-10 | But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me. For the sake of Christ, then, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. For when I am weak, then I am strong.
- 1 Peter 5:7 | Casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you.
- Hebrews 12:1-2 | Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us
 also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the
 race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy
 that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand
 of the throne of God."

- Psalm 23:4 | Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.
- Proverbs 3:5-6 | Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths."
- 1 John 16:33 | "I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world.
- Psalm 27:1 | The LORD is my light and my salvation— whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life— of whom shall I be afraid?
- Ecclesiastes 7:9 | Do not be quickly provoked in your spirit, for anger resides in the lap of fools.
- 2 Timothy 2:23-24 | Don't have anything to do with foolish and stupid arguments, because
 you know they produce quarrels. And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but must be
 kind to everyone, able to teach, not resentful.
- James 1:19-21 | My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry, because human anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires. Therefore, get rid of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent and humbly accept the word planted in you, which can save you.
- Proverbs 17:27 | The one who has knowledge uses words with restraint, and whoever has understanding is even-tempered.
- 2 Corinthians 4:8 | We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed."
- 1 Peter 5:10 | "And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast."
- Romans 12:21 | "Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."
